**Short description of the contract or purchase(s):**

The provision of 24/7 intravenous thrombolysis treatment is at the cornerstone of the National stroke strategy to provide world class stroke care (DH 2007). Safe administration of intravenous thrombolysis requires specialized clinical assessment by a consultant skilled to make thrombolysis and hyperacute treatment decisions.

There are currently a number of stroke units within South Central and neighbouring areas providing acute care and it has been agreed that these units will be facilitated to enable them all to provide high quality acute care, including thrombolysis.

Telemedicine has been identified as the solution to enable the facilitation of thrombolysis to be provided by all acute units.

Telemedicine equipment is to be implemented in 14 hospitals within South Central area and Salisbury to enable the provision of thrombolysis to eligible patients 24/7 from every hospital providing acute stroke care, and provision of TIA services 7/days week via telemedicine.
